- Limited assessments to 2 attempts per question.

Here are some other changes we made:

- **Slides & Layers Added:**
 - Added an interactive slide highlighting the three home ignition zones.
 - Added a recap slide with additional resources.
 - Add a references page.
- **Assessment Updates:**
 - Added a final assessment.
 - Added a hint layer for each assessment question, so users don't have to leave the assessment to review content.
 - Added a reset feature to all assessment questions, so that when a user tries again, their previous answers are cleared.
- **Other:**
 - Made updates to buttons, font, and layout so the pages are consistent throughout the course.
 - Added a "hover" state to all buttons.
 - Fixed animation issues with Smokey Bear and his text bubbles.
